Heather explained Nuvei, which is a company that provides external credit card processing. They provide services at no charge to the Village because all of their revenue comes from the processing fees they charge the consumer for using cards or bank ACH to pay their utility bills. They provide a link to post on the Village website and social media pages. They also provide a terminal for in-house transactions at no charge for the same reason as above. The Village recently purchased the credit card terminal we use for in-house transactions, but the processing fees are not passed on to the consumer. This company was referred by our billing software company because they already have compatible software. Discussion was tabled until the next meeting to allow time to get more information.

The Easter Egg Hunt was also discussed. Possible dates are March 21, 2026 or April 4, 2026. There is a tentative rental for March 21, but Heather will call them to confirm whether or not they are still wanting to rent the building. If they are not, the date will be March 21, 2026.
